Oct. 6 Kuo lecture to be simulcast in Scottsbluff

Digital advisor and strategist Kaiser Kuo will present a lecture Oct. 6 on “Shouting Across the Chasm: Chinese and American Netizens Clash in Cyberspace.”

Part of the 2009-10 E.N. Thompson Forum on World Issues, the lecture will be simulcast in Scottsbluff at Western Nebraska Community College’s Harms Advanced Technology Center, Room A113. The E.N Thompson lecture originates from the Lied Center for Performing Arts at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. The simulcast begins at 6 p.m. and is free and open to the public. A discussion on the topic will follow.

Born in the U. S. to Chinese parents, Kuo views China and America from many perspectives. A technology and business writer, Kuo also is founding member of Chinese metal band Tang Dynasty and continues to play guitar and bass for several bands, including the AC/DC tribute band The Dirty Deeds.
